2013-2014 Hilliard Bradley Swimming: A Record-Setting Season

The girls and boys swim teams finished their fifth season at Hilliard Bradley. As with the past three seasons, the team continued to participate in a unique relationship with the teams from Darby and Davidson. Head coach Brian Dickmann and assistant coaches Lynn Bowers and Dave Eagle coach the teams from all three Hilliard high schools. This relationship allowed the teams an opportunity to share valuable pool and coaching time. Additionally, the swimmers had an opportunity to train with other swimmers of similar ability and push each other to excel. While the three teams competed against each other throughout the season, it was amazing to see the swimmers bond together and cheer for one another. This was certainly an opportunity to watch good sportsmanship in action!

Six Bradley swimmers returned from last season: Jon Satre, Delaney Banda, Chester Bonnell, Kyra Sommer, Rebecca Woodson, and Hannah Zeis. There were also six new team members this year: Brynn Driscoll, Kaemer Henderson, Lizzie Hofinger, Trent Nguyen, Luke Rehbek,

and Abigail Shouse.

Throughout this season, several team records were broken. Senior Jon Satre set school records in the 50 yard freestyle, 100 yard freestyle, 200 yard freestyle, and 100 yard backstroke. His times in the 100 free and 200 free are also Hilliard open records. Freshman Brynn Driscoll set team records in the girls 200 yard individual medley and 100 yard breaststroke. Freshman Trent Nguyen set a record in the boys 100 yard breaststroke. The boys relays team of Bonnell, Nguyen, Rehbek and Satre set team records in the 200 yard medley relay, 200 yard freestyle relay, and 400 yard freestyle relay. The girls 200 medley team of Banda, Driscoll, Henderson and Woodson and the 200 freestyle relay team of Banda, Hofinger, Woodson, and Driscoll also set team records.

Several swimmers qualified to swim in the Central, East, Southeast Ohio District Championship on 2/15. Jon Satre finished 4th in the 200 yard freestyle and 6th in the 100 yard freestyle. His times in both of these swims were

in the top 24 in the state and qualified him for the State Championship again this year. Brynn Driscoll finished 10th in the 100 yard breaststroke and 18th in the 50 yard freestyle. Delaney Banda finished 28th in the 100 yard backstroke. The girls 200 medley relay and 400 freestyle relay finished 22nd and 23rd while the boys 200 medley relay and 400 freestyle relay finished 25th and 27th.

Hilliard's unique training methods paid off this season. For the first time in HCS history, students from all three high schools qualified for the State Championship. Additionally, swimmers from all three schools made it into finals and several school records and Hilliard open records were broken. During the meet, Jon dropped time in the 200 yard freestyle each time he swam it. With a 1:40.56 in finals, he finished 5th in the state. This is the highest state finish in Hilliard history. In addition, Jon broke his own school and Hilliard open records by 4.38 seconds. Jon finished 19th in the 100 backstroke, and Hilliard Bradley finished 35th out of 61 teams that scored points at the meet.

The season began strong when the team placed first the Fairmont Firebird Classic. The GMVWA holiday tournament in Dayton hosted 52 teams where Bradley placed 5th overall, and 2nd in large schools. At our own Porter Memorial Tournament the team placed first. Our wrestlers brought home more hardware, placing first in the Gahanna Duels, Groveport Cruiser Classic and Central Valley Tournament in PA. The team came in second in the OCC with only one heartbreaking loss to Westerville North. They wrapped up the regular season at Memorial Middle School with a nice win over Darby in an intense

atmosphere. The wrestling team had tremendous support all season from their fans. The seniors will be missed: Ryan Beveridge, Rob McGrath, Ryan McGrath, Mikael Perez, Jacob Pugh and Jake Stratton. The team will have a strong line-up next year as the JV team had a successful season placing 2nd in the OCC tournament. Hilliard Bradley competed in the postseason at the UA Sectional Tournament on 2/15, with 9 wrestlers qualifying for Districts: Keegan Driscoll, CJ Campbell, Riley Amador, Rob McGrath, Will Stratton, Ryan McGrath, Jake Stratton, Patrick Yeo and Ryan Beveridge. That was followed by



Districts at Hilliard Darby 2/21-22, with CJ Campbell and Jake Stratton winning the Division 1 District titles, and Rob McGrath and Keegan Driscoll placing 5th. CJ and Jake competed in the State Tournament at The Schottenstein Center on 2/27, 2/28 & 3/1. Rob and Keegan were on

stand-bye as Alternates. The wrestling team would like to thank all of the administration, staff, and students who came out and supported them this season.
