## Building On Last Year's Success

The Girls Cross Country team finished 3rd at the Otterbein Invitational. The team finished 2nd at the OCC Championships at Darby High School, the best team finish in school history.

Individually, Tes Corea shattered the school and junior class record at the OCC Championships finishing the race in 6th place in a time of 19:15. Sarah Hevener and Colleen Grainger finished 9th and 14th respectively, and Elaina Alpeter finished 17th.

The girls finished 5th as a team at the District Championships at Watkins Memorial High School, then finished in 10th place at the Regional Championships at Pickerington North High School, the best team finish in school history. Tes also competed at the State Championship at National Trail Raceway.
